Financial Update – Brad.

- KRCL is in a solid place financially.
- Even with the loss of funding we still came out higher than expected
- Over 6 months of revenue

Approve January 2026 budget draft – all.

Programming Updates – Ebay.

- Jan 1 we ran a curated music mix while the programming staff took the holiday off.
- Jan 19 we aired our annual MLK Day Programming, with it continuing to grow each year.. .
- Jan 22 we partnered with The State Room's 'Cinema Club' for a free screening of 'This Is Spinal Tap”, with 200 people in attendance and 300 rsvp’ing.
- The KRCL app has new updates including a voice recording feature, RSS feed for the daily RadioActive show posts, and you can now view KRCL YouTube videos straight from the app.
- Utah artist Trevor Dahl completed a new mural inside of KRCL, taking over 50hrs
- Coming up in Feb we're bringing back the 'KRCL Night Out' with a Madi Gras themed event at HK Brewing on Feb 17 from 6pm-9pm.
- For Black History Month we’ll be celebrating with Essential Artists on air & online.

General Manager Report: Gavin.

- We executed a new contract for rooftop equipment use with Giv accepting the board's requested changes from last month. KRCL gets free rent for 5 years and then we pay\$15/month with no escalation for 45 years.
- We are now up to 4,557 current members.
- Griffin Hall joined staff as assistant engineer
- Confirmed, Ryan McMullen will prepare design of our stage, with the hope it will be ready before a meeting with a potential naming donor
- Testing a new tool, wealth screening tool, designed to create a more intentional donor pool
- With the retiring of Erin from PMC Gavin proposed 2 potential solutions
 - create a new staff position
 - Stick with PMC and maybe get a new representative
- Gavin has decided to postpone the vehicle purchase until February
